## **Report on Heritage Walk to Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Loco Park**

The Department of History organised a Heritage Walk to Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Loco Park as part of the World Heritage Day celebrations. A total of 20 students participated in this educational visit. They were accompanied by two faculty members, Dr. Shreyashi Chaudhuri and Ms. Shampa Banerjee, along with Shri Ayan Kundu, the Documentation Officer of CRPCH. The students thoroughly enjoyed this unique learning experience. Deshbandhu Loco Park, established on 29 July 2006 with only two exhibits, has steadily expanded over the years and now features 14 well-maintained displays. The latest addition to the park is the Amrit Digital Gallery, inaugurated on 19 October 2023, which offers engaging and informative digital content related to railway heritage.

The group was guided by Mr. Partha Chatterjee, a staff member of CLW, who provided valuable insights into the various models and engines on display. His detailed explanations helped the students gain a deeper understanding of the evolution of locomotives in India and the historical significance of the exhibits. The park houses an impressive array of railway models, engines, and artefacts that reflect the rich legacy of Indian railway development. Following the tour of the park, the students also visited the exhibition gallery showcasing railway technology, heritage displays, and additional educational models, including information on the local flora and fauna.

The Heritage Walk proved to be an enriching and informative experience, enabling students to appreciate the importance of preserving both industrial and cultural heritage. The visit successfully aligned with the objectives of World Heritage Week by fostering awareness and interest in safeguarding historical assets for future generations.
