The Department of Sanskrit, Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya organized a Special Lecture on “Brahmi Script” on 9th December in Room No. 302 of the Department of Sanskrit. The programme was conducted as part of the department’s academic enrichment activities aimed at familiarizing students with India’s ancient knowledge systems.

The lecture was delivered by Dr. Subhankar Basak, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Sanskrit, Kulti College. The programme was further honored by the presence of the Principal of Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya as the Special Guest, whose presence added academic significance to the event.

During the lecture, the students were introduced to the historical importance of the Brahmi script as the earliest known script of the Indian subcontinent. The speaker elaborated on how almost all Indian scripts evolved from the Brahmi script, discussed various epigraphical evidences and inscriptions written in Brahmi, explained the structure and alphabet of the Brahmi script, and conducted practical exercises to familiarize students with the writing of Brahmi characters.


