

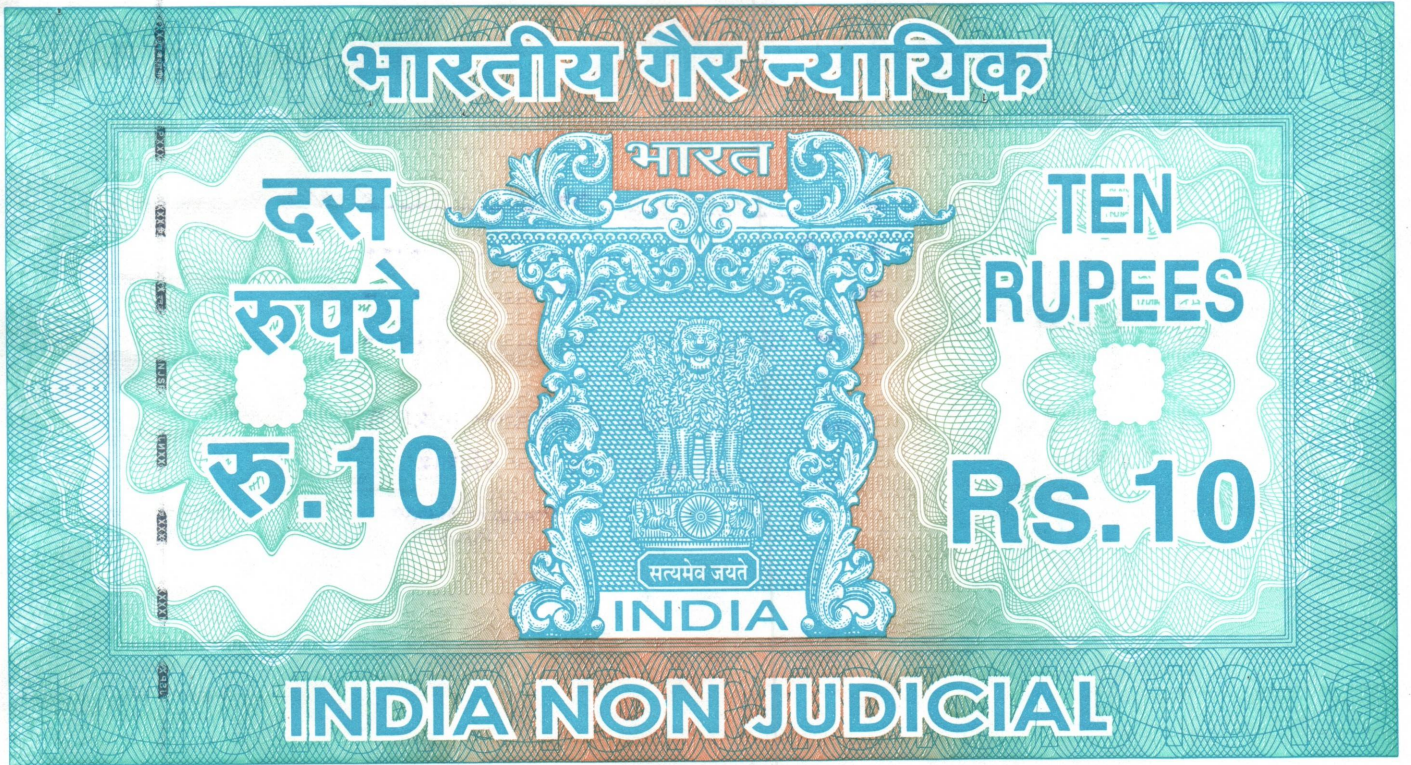

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**JAIN VISHVA BHARTI INSTITUTE (JVBI) AND DESHABANDHU
MAHAVIDYALAYA, CHITTARANJAN (W.B.)**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") effective as of ^{30/5/2023} ("Effective Date"), is entered into by and between Acharya Kalu Kanya Mahavidyalaya (referred as AKKM), a constituent college of Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (JVBI), Ladnun, Rajasthan and Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan, are hereinafter referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

AKKM (the constituent college), Jain Vishva Bharati Institute

1. AKKM was established in the year 1997, as the first constituent college of the JVBI for conduction of Undergraduate programmes for girls in the field of Science, Commerce and Arts.
2. Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed University) was established with the inspiration of GurudevTulsi. In 1991, Government of India notified JVBI as Deemed-to-be University, under Section o3 of University Grants Commission Act, 1956. Gurudev Shri Tulsi remained its first constitutional Anushasta (for moral and spiritual guidance), followed by Acharya Shri Mahaprajna as its second Anushasta. Acharya Mahashraman is the present Anushasta.
3. Jain Vishva Bharati Institute is committed to provide the highest quality of educational services to the utmost satisfaction of the students and give them an opportunity to

cultivate an integrated personality blended with spirituality and moral values. The Institute is located in Ladnun (Nagaur District), Rajasthan. The spiritual ambience of the campus provides a peaceful atmosphere of the traditional "Gurukul", and is ideal for studies and research. The academic environment of the campus fosters self-discipline and promotes quality of the life and commitment to higher values.

4. The institution is only of its kind committed to research in field of Oriental Studies in general and Jainology in particular. The practice of pragmatic principles such as Anekant, Non-violence, Tolerance and Peaceful Co-existence are the noble ideals of this Institute. JVBI continuously strive hard to achieve excellence in training, extension and experimentation in various branches of learning compatible to the mission of the Institute.

Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya, also known as Chittaranjan College

1. Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya, also known as Chittaranjan College, established in 1973, is a general Degree college at Chittaranjan, in Asansol, Paschim Bardhaman district. It offers undergraduate courses in arts, commerce and sciences. It is affiliated to Kazi Nazrul University, Asansol.

Therefore, both parties are agreeable to enter into a MOU for where AKKM shall act as a knowledge partner and provide support, Faculty training and exchange, Student exchange, Curriculum development and other Academic activities.

Objectives:

1. To develop innovation in work process
2. To establish interrelationship through faculty and students exchange programmes
3. To promote the principles of Human values in the students and staff of the Institute
4. To promote the skills of Yoga and Science of Living in the students to make them better citizens
5. To organise Workshops/Seminars/Conferences/faculty Development Programmes, etc.
6. To develop the skills on Indian Knowledge System, like Prakrit, Sanskrit, Jain Religion and Philosophy in line with the requirements of NEP 2020
7. To offer courses in conjunction for the students which may include credit transfer for attainment in degree/diploma, etc
8. To establish a Mentor-Mentee relationship as AKKM - Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya
9. To promote professional development
10. To propose programmes for MoU

The Colleges shall exchange faculties and students to promote the activities of Human Values, Humanities, Peace and skills of Yoga and Science of Living.



Article I: Principle of Cooperation

- a. To promote scholars, students and personnel of both the Colleges.
- b. To provide opportunities to both students and faculty to use the maximum expertise and facilities available in the mentor organizations through training of students and staff and through exchange of thoughts by discussion related to innovation in recent educational trends.

Article II: Areas of Cooperation

- a. Exchanging information on faculty and students and exchange programme of students and faculty relating to educational activities.
- b. Exchanging faculty for providing Consultancy to the other party for skilling of the students in areas of Human values, professional ethics, Life skills, Humanities, etc.

This MoU will be effective from the date of signing until the parties agree to terminate it.

Either Party may terminate this MOU as follows:

- a. This MoU may be terminated by mutual written consent of both the parties.
- b. Either Party may terminate this MoU without assigning any reason by giving thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the other Party.





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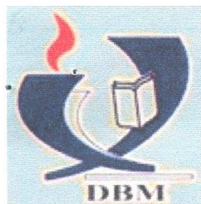
