And whereas Both the PARTIES have decided to enter into this MoU, which defines the framework for the co-operation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

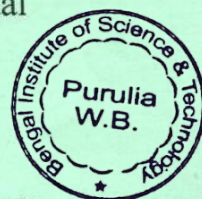
On the basis of equality and reciprocity and mutual benefit, the PARTIES agree to implement programs through mutual cooperation which includes but not limited to:

- Faculty/staff exchange programs.
- Exchange of information on teaching, learning materials and other literatures relevant to their educational and research programs.
- Cultural exchange like commemoration of birth anniversaries of renowned personalities, observance of different international/national days, celebration of local festivals, inter-college cultural competitions, games and sports etc. may be organized jointly.
- NSS activities: The colleges can share a few programs of NSS activities as per the convenience and feasibility of both the colleges.
- Promote and encourage collaborative research projects (submission of the project proposal to the funding agencies like CSIR, DST, UGC etc.) and other scholarly co-operation, particularly on Sustainable Development, Tribal Studies, Linguistics, Medicinal Plants, Environment and other areas as decided from time to time.
- Implementation of NEP 2020 in a structured manner.
- Initiatives to run innovative interdisciplinary courses.
- Collaboration of events to accelerate entrepreneurship and innovation.
- To organize seminars, conference or workshops jointly on the topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- To develop "Innovation and Incubation Center" in a collaborative manner.
- Use laboratory resources to benefit each other.
- To encourage students, staffs and faculty members to use library facilities in a shared manner.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each PARTY shall designate a member of its teaching faculty to serve as the program coordinator on behalf of the principal of the College. A Coordination Committee, comprising two principals and two coordinators, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between both the PARTIES.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Each PARTY will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both the PARTIES.

ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Three years commencing from the effective date; which maybe extended beyond the term of three years by written agreement signed by both the PARTIES.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION

Each PARTY may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of Three months in advance to the other PARTY.

ARTICLE 6: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This MoU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 7: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both PARTIES will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.
