Both the PARTIES have many areas of common interest, considerable advantage which may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy, research and community development initiatives besides offering "value added programs of study" and "add on courses" to enhance the employability of the students and thus to benefit students in someway or other.

And whereas Both the PARTIES have decided to enter into this MoU, which defines the framework for the co-operation of the two institutions in the following sections.

#### ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

On the basis of equality and reciprocity and mutual benefit, the PARTIES agree to implement programs through mutual cooperation which includes but not limited to:

- · Faculty/staff exchange programs.
- Exchange of information on teaching, learning materials and other literatures relevant to their educational programs.
- Cultural exchange like commemoration of birth anniversaries of renowned personalities, observance of different international/national days, celebration of local festivals, inter-college cultural competitions, games and sports etc. may be organized jointly.
- Sharing expertise and resources, both institutions can work together to create highquality educational experiences for students
- Organizing joint events, competitions, or academic challenges can foster collaboration and friendly competition between students from both institutions, stimulating academic growth and creativity.
- Implementation of NEP 2020 in a structured manner.
- Collaboration of events to accelerate professional development.
- Collaborative efforts may include mechanisms for quality assurance and evaluation to ensure that the activities conducted under the MoU meet the agreedupon standards and objectives.
- Implementing literacy and numeracy initiatives targeted at tribal children and adults, including after-school tutoring programs, adult education classes, and community libraries.

#### **ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION**

Each PARTY shall designate a member of its teaching faculty to serve as the program coordinator on behalf of the principal of the College. A Coordination Committee, comprising two principals and two coordinators, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between both the PARTIES.

#### ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Each PARTY will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both the PARTIES.

#### **ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY**

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Three years commencing from the effective date; which maybe extended beyond the term of three years by written agreement signed by both the PARTIES.

#### **ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION**

Each PARTY may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of Three months in advance to the other PARTY.

#### ARTICLE 6: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This MoU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

#### **ARTICLE 7: DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both PARTIES will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.
