

Report on the Workshop on Honey Bee Environment and Livelihood

The programme was attended by both teachers and students, who showed great enthusiasm for learning about bee ecology and the significance of apiculture. The workshop featured a comprehensive PowerPoint presentation delivered by the resource persons from the Moubliss Society. Through visually engaging slides, they explained the crucial role of bees in pollination, biodiversity conservation, and maintaining ecological balance. A particularly engaging part of the workshop was the segment on different varieties of honey.
