

Report on Thalassemia Awareness and Detection:

The programme aimed at spreading awareness to the greater is society around the College i.e. in the locality of Chittaranjan, Rupnarayanpur and adjoining villages. The programme commenced with RabindraSangeet presented by prof.Devlina Chowdhury, Assistant Professor of Bengali.
