



Very little is known of the personal history of Kalidasa. Many anecdotes regarding his early life are current in India. He is supposed to have been an idiot in his early years and was married by chance to a princess –Vasanti, daughter of the king of Benares who repudiated him on finding that he was a dullard. He propitiated Kali and hence received the name, Kalidasa. Another story connects him with Kumara- dasa, the king of Ceylon, who burnt himself on knowing that Kalidasa was murdered by a hetaira greedy of the prize for completing a verse. The tradition is absurd. Yet another account mentions him as one of the nine gems at the court of Vikramaditya of Ujjain who founded the Samvat era in 57 B.C. Other stories and conjectures regard him as a king of Kashmir, named Matrigupta. European scholars regard him as a contemporary of Skandagupta, while others him in the reign of Chandragupta II. We are inclined to accept his contemporaneity with Vikrama, founder of the Samvat era.

He is supposed to be a resident of Ujjain, though every province Bengal, Vidarbha, Kashmere and even Ceylon- claim him. He appears to be a court-poet and seems to have lived in affluence. There is no note of desperation as in Bhavabhuti. Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya's Students Commence program with singing the Mantra सं गच्छध्वं सं वदाध्वं......Then our principal sir, Dr. Tridib Santapa Kundu Started the program with various information about Mahakevi Kalidasa. Dr. Sudhamoy Halder, Assistant Professor, Department of Sanskrit, Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, The chief speaker of the program, delivered valuable speech on the title of Kalidasa and his writing, He discussed in details he biography of Mahakavi Kelidasa, his period and his contribution to Sanskrit Litursture. The climax of Kalidasa's Art is the conclusion of Indian culture, which the Puranic-Literature calls Bhukti- mukti-krddharma, the religion of the fulfilment of the legitimate desires of life and the complete liberation from all possible types of Bondage i. e, salvation. #### Report on Mrcchakatika: A Literary Introduction

Title of the Event: Mrcchakatika: A Literary Introduction

The Department of English, Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan organized a special lecture on Mrcchakatika by Sudraka in collaboration with the Department of Sanskrit. It is one of the first formal inter-departmental faculty exchange programs, where Dr. Sudhamoy Halder from the Department of Sanskrit addressed the Semester 3Honoursstudents on a particular classical Sanskrit text as prescribed in their syllabus for the paper Classical Indian and European Literature BAHENGC303. The session took place on September 27, 2022 in the Seminar Room at 12:30 pm, and was presided over by our respected Principal Dr. Tridib Santapa Kundu. The session was also attended by the IQAC coordinator of the Institute Dr. Apurbo Kumar Roy, and the seniormost member of the Languages faculty Dr. Sagar Chandra Bandyopadhyay. Dr. Halder started with the ideas pertaining to the stylistics of Sanskrit plays, and how it has evolved over the centuries. He later commented on the grand narrative of Sudraka, the playwright of the text, who was also a King in his own right. According to Dr. Halder, Sudraka's departure from Bharata's tenets in the Natyashastraisinteresting, as despite his stature as a King, Sudraka incorporated the daily musings of many middle and working class individuals, whereas Natyashastra considered them too trivial to be represented in a play. Moreover, Sudraka's avoidance of the myths and epics, show a curious interest for the everyday humdrum 'prakrit' life of the ordinary folk. Dr. Halder also systematically analysed the title of the play as a two-way metaphor, where Charudutta and Vasantsena's love is as fragile and as ornamental as a "little clay cart," and the quaint domesticity of the play's overall tone. Dr. Halder went on to critically comment on the different characters of the play-- Vasantsena, Charudutta, Madanika, Sarvilak and Samsthanaka. There is also a parallel social revolution which puts Sudraka's political inclinations strangely in perspective. Students were spellbound by Dr. Halder's lucid descriptions and erudite arguments. Many informed questions were asked including the possibility of Sudraka deriving the plotline of the play from Bhasa's extant fragment of prose. Dr. Halder enthusiastically addressed the questions, and promised the Department of English to hold extra classes the following academic year to teach the text to the batch in full details.



## Report on Language and style of Valmiki Ramayana

Event Name: Language and style of Valmiki Ramayana

**Description of Event:** 

Srimad Valmiki Ramayana is composed of verses called Sloka, in Sanskrit language, which is an ancient language from India and a complex meter called Anustup. These verses are grouped into individual chapters called Canto, where in a specific event or intent is told. These chapters or sarga are grouped into books called Kanda where Kanda means the internode stem of sugar cane, or also a particular phase of the story or an event in the course of story telling. Valmiki Ramayana is an epic poem of India which narrates the journey of Virtue to annihilate vice. Sri Rama is the Hero and aayana His journey. We in India believe that Sri Rama lived in Treta Yug, millennia B.C and we are presently concerned with what Srimad Valmiki Ramayana tells us, rather than when it was told.

This epic poem Ramayana is a smriti which is translated as "from memory". Given the antiquity of Srimad Valmiki Ramayana, there have been some interjected verses. Sometimes these verses can be contradicting. However, scholars, grammarians, historians have put a lot of effort to standardize the original text, by verifying various manuscripts available from various parts of India, thus trying to stabilize and save the text from further contradictions. An example of this effort is the critical edition of Srimad Valmiki Ramayana. This site aims to study various versions of Srimad Valmiki Ramayana and arrive at a version of Ramayana that is most relevant to modern times. Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya's Students Commence program with singing the Mantra "ॐ पूर्णमद: पूर्णमदम् पूर्णम् पूर्णम् दच्यते"

......Then our principal sir, Dr. Tridib Santapa Kundu Started the program with various infomation about Mahakavi Valmiki. Dr. Ujjwal Sardar, Assistant Professor, Department of Sanskrit, Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, The chief speaker of the program, delivered valuable specch on the title of Language and style of Valmiki, He discussed in details he biography of Mahakavi Valmiki, his period and his contribution to Sanskrit Litursture. And he discussed the poetic style of epic poet Valmiki and the language of his poetry. The fact that the epic poet Kalidasa took the theme of his epic 'Raghuvansham' from the Ramayana written by the ancient poet Valmiki is evident from the title of the epic. It is recognized by the poet that he was inspired by the imagination of the Ramayana in constructing the them of his "Meghdutam" lyric. Moreover, the great poet while acknowledging his literary debate to his illustrious predecessor says -- " अथवा कृतवाग् द्वारे वंशे अस्मिन् पूर्वसूरिभि: । मणौ वज्रसमुत्कीर्णे

सूत्रस्येवास्ति मे गति:। Kalidasa's reputation as a poet is largely due to the novelty and excellence of the similes. Despite the infinity and freshness of Kalidasa's similes, it cannot be denied that in many cases the original poet Valmiki's Ramayana is the source of all these similes. For example, in the "Uttaramegha" section of the "Meghdutam" lyric poem, Birahini refers to the exiled Yaksha Megha in
