
Report on Tree Plantation Programme

Report of Thalassemia Awareness and Detection camp held on 05.01.2024

Thalassemia Awareness and Detection camp, organised by the NSS unit of Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan in collaboration with Lions club of Asansol megacity on 05.01.2024, Friday, as a part of the Students' week from 02.01.2024 to 08.01.2024. The programme aimed at spreading awareness to the greater is society around the College i.e. in the locality of Chittaranjan, Rupnarayanpur and adjoining villages. The programme commenced with Rabindra Sangeet "অরপ তোমার বাণী, অঙ্গে আমার, চিত্তে আমার মুক্তি দিক্ সে আনি" (formless is thy message; let it bring emancipation to my inner and outer self. Let me be blessed to have the emancipation) presented by Dr Devlina Chowdhury, Assistant Professor of Bengali.

In the introductory speech, Hon'ble Principal Dr Tridib Santapa Kundu emphasised on the purpose of the programme saying prevention is better than cure. Pre-marital detection of thalassemia can avert this disease.

Sri Tapan Mahata, District Chairperson, Thalassemia Awareness and Detection, in his speech discussed on the technicality of this disease. He pointed out that the probability of taking birth of a child with thalassemia can be averted if and only if both the marital partners are 'Carrier'. That is why this programme was significant.

Dr Vaskar Hazra, Assistant Superintendent of Asansol district hospital dealt with the adverse impact on the patient himself/ herself as well as on the family of the patient. The cost of medical treatment including blood transfusion at regular interval is as much as Rs 2.5 lakh per annum if government aid is not available. In addition to that if a thalassemia patient is further victim of any other complicated disease, then the problem gets compounded. In spite of best possible medical support, a thalassemia patient's life span is very limited.

The total number of students participated in detection test was 61 of them 48 were girls and 13 boys.
