
Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan Students' Feedback Analysis and Action Taken (2023-24)




8. Attendance record of the students is maintained by the teacher




9. The teacher informs the students about the learning objectives and course outcomes




10. The teacher guides the students for their overall personality development and ease in use of ICT based methods of teaching






13. The teacher uses student-centric method of teaching


18. The prescribed books/reading materials are available in the library


19. Laboratories are well equipped




20. Toilets/Washrooms are clean and properly maintained




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



23. Efforts taken by the college to improve the quality of teaching and learning








The following points emerged from the analysis of students' feedback survey:

- Most of the students are satisfied with the way of teaching, communication skill, punctuality in the classroom and ability to clarify doubts of their teachers.
- Majority of students think that teachers use students' centric methods of teaching effectively and internal evaluation by teachers was also fair and unbiased.
- Most of them have the opinion that teachers guides them for overall personality development and uses ICT based methods for effective curriculum delivery.
- Most of the students' are satisfied with the overall performances of their teachers.
- Some students were not satisfied with the availability of the prescribed books and reading materials in the library.
- Some students given the opinion to make the laboratories better equipped.
- A reasonable number of students suggested for proper cleaning and maintaining the toilets and washrooms.
- Some students also raised the issue of adequate availability of drinking water
- Majority of the students are satisfied with the ambience and overall teaching and mentoring process of the college.

Action taken Report:

From the analysis it can be interpreted that majority of the students are happy with the overall teaching learning and infrastructural aspects of the college. Few students have some issues on drinking water availability, toilets and washrooms cleaning, laboratory equipment, books availability in library. Based on the analysis, IQAC in consultation with principal, called for meetings to discuss raised issues and suggestions. Accordingly, It was decided that necessary actions will be taken.
